Volunteer Check List - From Initial Enquiry to Enrolment – last updated 27 June 2022

When we receive your initial email enquiry from our website, we will email you back and suggest a chat on the phone so we can talk to you about it and answer any queries.

If you are interested in being a patrol volunteer (street watcher) this is the enrolment process:

Please download these documents from our website and read or watch as appropriate:

- 1. Observers Guide.
- 2. Induction Presentation (video).
- 3. Safeguarding links (video).
- 4. Privacy Notice.
- 5. Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form.
- 6. Insurance Certificate (for info only).
- 7. List of Safe Havens (we suggest bookmarking the PDF on your mobile).
- 8. Calendar Rota Instructions (we will send you the link to the rota once you have enrolled).

If you are happy to proceed:

- 9. If you do not have a valid DBS, please apply thro DBS Procedure document on our website.
- 10. Please write your name, sign, date and scan the following and email to us at streetwatchqpkr@gmail.com:
 - a. Page 10 of the Observers Guide (NB: no need for witness signature).
 - b. Page 2 of the Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form.
- 11. Emma will then contact you to welcome you to the patrol and answer any further queries.
- 12. Emma will add you to our Whatsapp Group if you are happy to be included. This a very useful way for the Co-ordinators and patrol volunteers to communicate news, to ask for a partner if they see that no one has signed up yet or equally to cancel if they cant make a shift.
- 13. You can patrol once you've received your DBS just email us a copy at streetwatchqpkr@gmail.com.
- 14. We will then send you the rota link and see below for what to do on your first patrol.

Typical Patrol Shift:

- 1. **Sign up in advance to rota** (NB: Emma regularly checks the rota to ensure any new volunteers are with a regular patrol volunteer for their first patrol).
- 2. Check rota before going out on patrol to ensure there are at least 2 people available for the patrol. If not, it cant go ahead.
- 3. Bring your mobile (with PDF of Safe Havens).
- 4. **Meeting time and place** 3.30pm or 4.30pm (depending on which shift you are doing) at corner of Wrentham Ave and Chamberlayne Rd.
- 5. **Collect Hi Vis Tabard (if first patrol)/Sign in** at Winkworths (2nd office on LHS on Chamberlayne Rd if you are coming from Verandah).
- 6. Patrol in pairs in your tabard.
- 7. **Report at end of patrol** one patrol volunteer needs to report the streets patrolled and any incidents (procedure is in accident book at Winkworths) on the electronic calendar rota.
- 8. **If calling 101** they may suggest logging report online but please keep on the phone as that is the guickest way to get your report logged and actioned.
- 9. Sign out at Winkworths.
